Performance

Delivering a maximum 64kw at 6,000rpm and 123Nm at 4,000rpm, this engine ups the power but still delivers reduced fuel consumption and a smooth, quiet drive.

Idle stop and go system (ISG)

Come to a stop in the new Picanto and intelligence takes over. The engine shuts off by itself, saving fuel. Automatically restarting again when you move off. It's just what you need when driving in congested city streets.



Manual or automatic

Choose from either a five-speed manual or four-speed automatic transmission. Each offers smooth, effortless gear shifting.

Safety and stability



Class leading safety

On its own, character isn't enough. A car needs to be complete from every single standpoint. Beneath the up-to-date body shell the Picanto's designers have built in the latest class-leading safety measures, resulting in a 5-Star ANCAP safety rating.

Vehicle Stability Management (VSM)

VSM works in conjunction with Motor Driven Power Steering to ensure the car stays stable when simultaneously braking and cornering.

Rear parking assist

Protect your Picanto with this easy system designed to show you exactly how much room you have at the back when reversing and parking. A warning sound tells you when you're too close to an object.

Electronic Stability Control (ESC)

Sensors detect wheel speed and steering angle when you apply the brakes, delivering the appropriate braking force to each individual wheel to maintain steering control and slow you down safely.

Seven airbags

Up to seven airbags in total: one each for the driver and front seat passenger, two at the sides, two curtain airbags the length of the cabin, and one at the driver's knee.

Hill-start Assist Control (HAC)

We know what it's like when you have to pull away from a standing start when you're on a steep upward incline. HAC stops you from rolling backwards.

The Picanto has so many ways to make everything about driving effortless. That's because it does all the things you want it to do, with no fuss or bother. Load it up, easily park it, and let it get you there - every feature helps in some way.

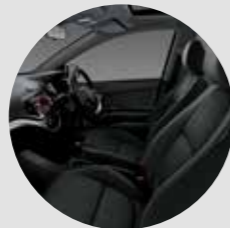
Audio remote control

Bluetooth hands-free lets you talk on the phone without taking your hands from the steering wheel, and also lets you stream music through the car's speakers.



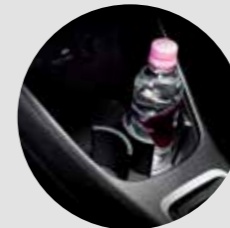
Door map pocket

A large open tray on the floor console provides additional storage space.



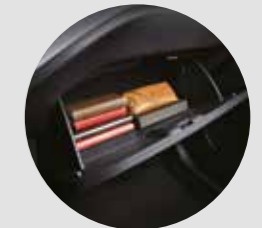
Rotating dual cup holders

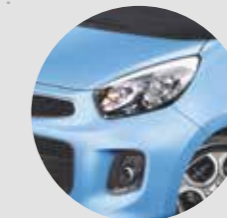

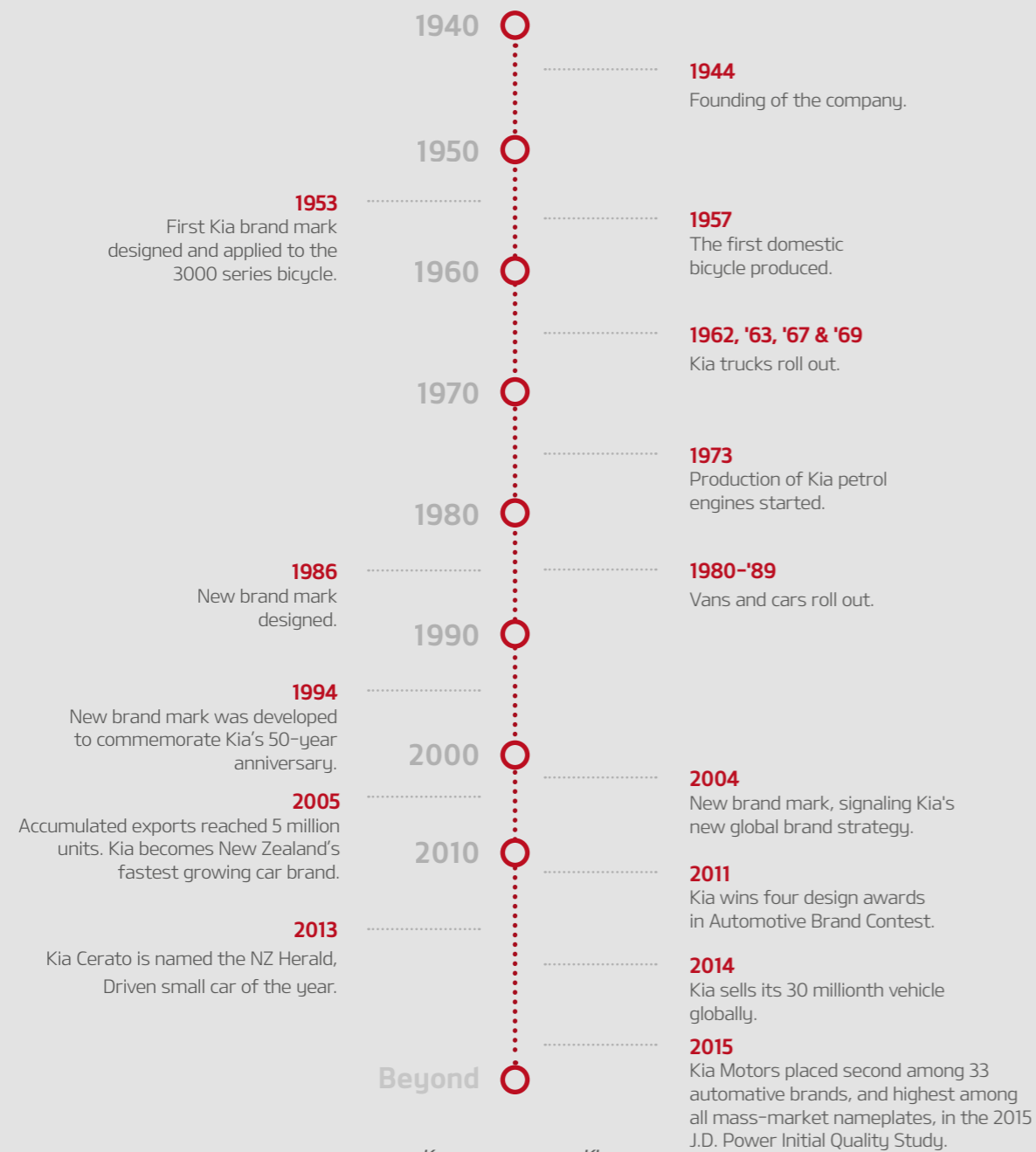

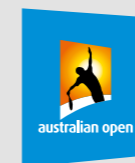
INCIDENT CARE
